

**RED HOT SUMMER TOUR – EVENT INFORMATION**  
**MOUNT PENANG PARKLANDS | SUNDAY JANUARY 23**

**VENUE**

Mount Penang Parkland located in Kariong. Access to the event is via Gate 2 – Kangoo Rd. The venue is a magnificent grassed open-air venue. Patrons must bring a camp chair or picnic rug to the event. All areas of this venue have view of the stage.

**COVID 19**

This event is approved to proceed under the NSW Government Public Events Framework. Patrons are required as a condition of entry to comply with any current mandates imposed by the NSW Health Department. These requirements are fluid and may change at any time. The Red Hot Summer Tour are 100% committed to providing you with a Covid Safe Event.

- All patrons must bring a camp chair / picnic rug to the event.
- This event will have no mosh pit or dancefloor.
- Patrons are required to remain in their social groups and congregations of groups will not be permitted.
- Patrons are requested to remain seated where possible.
- Please adhere to directions of staff and security and maintain social distancing at all times.
- Patrons must bring a face mask with you to this event and ensure you wear the mask at any point where you cannot socially distance.
- Patrons must sign in via the Event QR Code at the Point of Entry. Covid Marshals will be on hand to assist you if you have any difficulties.

The capacity for this event has been restricted to allow enough room for patrons to sit comfortably and move around the site with ease. Measures taken to improve your safety at this event:

**TICKET TYPES**

*General Admission* tickets are \$128.90 including booking and credit fees. Transaction fees may apply. Patrons with General Admission tickets will receive access to the main lawn area, where unreserved seating is available ( BYO Camp Chair )

**TRANSPORT / PARKING**

A shuttle service will operate to and from the event from Gosford Train Station. Shuttles will run with departures at 12.00, 12.40, 1.20, 2.00, 2.40, 3.20pm. Buses will return to Gosford Train Station after the event conclusion.

**DISABLED PATRONS**

Disabled parking is available in an unreserved area within close proximity to the event entry – please follow directions of parking staff for access. Once inside the venue, patrons may take advantage of a dedicated viewing area located on the concourse at the rear of the site. This area is unreserved and available for disabled patrons and their immediate carer only. The Red Hot Summer Tour accepts companion cards for an immediate carer attending the event with a disabled patron. Please present your accreditation at entry to gate staff. Patrons please note that this is an outdoor venue with some uneven surfaces and is open to the elements. If you require any assistance on the day please ask one of our staff or security.

**BOX OFFICE / TICKETING**

The Box Office is located at the concert entry point and will be open 60 minutes prior to gates opening until the headline artist commences. Please have your ticket printed and ready for scanning at the gates.

### **FOOD & BEVERAGE**

This event will have a large range of food available for purchase, and includes menu items for intolerances and vegetarian / vegan patrons.

A public bar will also operate for the event duration offering a range of Beer, Wine, Cider, Spirits and Non Alcoholic Beverages. To comply with NSW Licensing Beer, Cider and Spirits served will be Mid Strength.

A large range of Artist and exclusive Tour Merchandise will be available for the event duration from the merchandising facility adjacent to the bar.
